

## Reflecting on Richard: Some Thoughts on Richard III on the Anniversary of his Death

I first encountered Richard III as an undergraduate in 1998. He formed a key part of my undergraduate studies, my honours dissertation, and my doctoral work. While I have moved onto teaching and researching other areas, the last Yorkist king has remained a fascinating, spellbinding historical figure for me. In this talk, I will sketch out some aspects of Richard's life, what my research into him has led me to believe, and how we now see Richard in the wake of the discovery of his body in 2012.

Dr Andrew Broertjes is an honorary research fellow at the University of Western Australia, where he gained his PhD in 2007. He has since taught across the Schools of Humanities, Population Health, and Allied Health at UWA, and at ECU and Curtin University.
